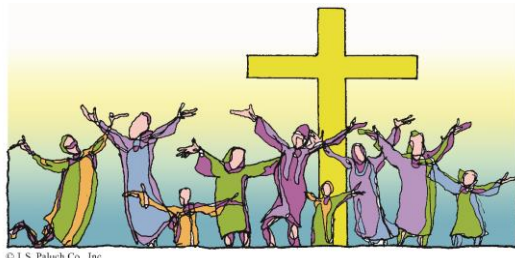

TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's Scripture Readings

FIRST READING: The LORD has rescued the poor from the clutches of the wicked (Jeremiah 20:10-13).

PSALM: Lord, in your great love, answer me (Psalm 69).

SECOND READING: The grace of God overflows for all (Romans 5:12-15).

GOSPEL: All who acknowledge Jesus before others will likewise be acknowledged by Jesus before the Father (Matthew 10:26-33).

Norms for the Distribution and Reception of Holy Communion: The Second Vatican Council gave renewed consideration to Communion under both kinds. Aware of the doctrinal principles on the complete efficacy of Eucharistic Communion under the species of bread alone, the Council gave permission for Communion under both kinds. This is a clearer form of the Sacrament, offering a particular opportunity of deepening the understanding of the mystery in which the faithful take part. On the night before He died, the Lord took bread and said, "Eat," then He took the chalice and said, "Drink." The faithful are encouraged to partake of the Body and Blood of Christ under both species of bread and wine. C.f. General Instruction of the Roman Missal, 2011, Number 14. Norms for the Distribution and Reception of Holy Communion under Both Kinds in the Diocese of United States of America, 2112, Numbers 17-20.
