Second Sunday of Easter Divine Mercy Sunday April 7, 2024

<u>FIRST READING:</u> With great power the apostles bore witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus

(Acts 4:32-35).

<u>PSALM:</u> Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his love is everlasting (Psalm 118).

SECOND READING: The victory that conquers the world is our faith (1 John 5:1-6).

GOSPEL: — Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed (John 20:19-31).

LITURGICAL REFLECTION Divine Mercy Sunday Year B focuses on the concept of belief in the unseen, inspired by John 20:19-31, where Jesus helps Thomas overcome his doubts. The Scripture reading recounts how Jesus appeared to his disciples, offered peace, and showed his wounds to Thomas, who doubted until he saw Jesus himself. This story emphasizes that faith can be challenging but is rewarding and vital for understanding and experiencing God's mercy and love. Through Jesus' interaction with Thomas, we learn that doubt can lead to deeper faith and that belief without seeing is blessed. As Christians, we must "walk by faith, not by sight" (2 Cor. 5:7).
